## BONDING AND INFILLING (AFTER UNROLLING AND MATCHING)





- 1 Untuck the edges of two matched grass carpets
- 2 Unroll the bonding tape
- 3 Apply the glue on the tape.
- 4 Close one, then the other side of the grass carpet.
- 5 Press the seam of grass carpets for about 30 minutes.
- 6 The seamed grass surface can be filled with sand and rubber granules 24 hours after the completion of gluing.

## ANNOTATIONS

2  Use the same standard seaming tape as you would use for tufted grass.

3  For gluing woven grass, you can use dedicated, high-quality glues that have been tested in laboratories for the strength of the glued joint and have met the requirements of the standard. Adhesives of the following companies have been tested and approved to be used for the woven products made by: MAPEI, POLYCHEM SYSTEMS, STAUF.

- If the installer intends to use any glue other than specified above, it must be checked by the installer before gluing woven grass. The installer must make sure that the strength of the glued joint is sufficient and meets the requirements of the standard.

6  A characteristic feature of woven artificial grass is the vertical pile fixation, which makes the infill process visibly easier.

It is estimated that the time need for filling in of the woven grass is 50% of the time required to infill the tufted grass.
